Dear Senator \_\_\_\_\_,

As your constituent, **I'm writing to ask you to cosponsor Senate Bill 1471**, urging the president to declassify a 28-page finding on foreign government support of the 9/11 hijackers. This finding is in the report of the Joint Inquiry into Intelligence Community Activities Before and After the Terrorist Attacks of September 2001.

The chairman and vice chairman of the 9/11 Commission and the Senate co-chair of the inquiry that produced the 28 pages have said there's no national security reason to keep this information classified and that Americans need and deserve to know what the government knows.

**When you reply, I would like you to answer two specific questions:**

- **Have you read the 28 pages?**
- **If not, have you requested permission from the Senate Intelligence Committee to do so?**

It's important to me that you read the 28 pages—because it's impossible for you to reach fully informed conclusions about U.S. defense and foreign policy without knowing about sources of foreign support of the 9/11 hijackers. I want to read the 28 pages for the very same reason.
